Reporting to the **Sports Development Officer – Trampoline**, the Team Leader Trampoline & Tumbling will provide leadership across recreational, development, and competitive trampoline programs. The role combines coaching, athlete development, staff mentoring, program coordination, and operational support to ensure outstanding participant experiences and athlete outcomes.

- Current NSW Working With Children Check
- Current Class C Driver Licence.

Desirable

- Experience mentoring or supervising coaches
- Knowledge of Gymnastics Australia pathways and frameworks
- Administration and reporting experience
- Trampoline Judging Accreditation or willingness to obtain.
